**Conversation Game** เกมบทสนทนา

INSTRUCTOR NOTE: Ask two students to stand up in front of the class. One student should ask the other student "Do you have a job?" The second student should respond using one of the conversation examples shown above. Their response should contain a question that continues the conversation. (Remind them of the "ping-pong" metaphor.) Both students should respond appropriately using as many words as possible. Encourage them to continue conversing with at least 3 pairs of responses.
