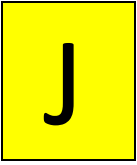


Lesson 10: J



Instructor Notes: Even though the Thai alphabet has a consonant that corresponds to the English letter J, the words in this lesson are particularly difficult for Thai speakers to pronounce correctly. "Joke", "Jump", and "Jungle" are the easiest words in this list. "Junior" may be the most difficult.
