**NOTES:**

Words that start with S and end in other consonants such as T or R are challenging. Triple consonant combinations such as School or Script are even more difficult. Other words that start with S: Saturday, School, Sun, Sunday,

Thai speakers are reluctant to stick out their tongue due to cultural reasons, however this is necessary in order to pronounce T. Show examples and make it fun. Other words that start with T: Test, Thirty, Took, Thirsty, Trash, Trip. **Tall and Tree were removed.** Three and Truck were added.
