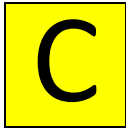

The Thai language has several consonants that sound like C and K. We will cover words with CR in a separate lesson. The CL sound is also hard for Thai speakers to pronounce correctly. The words “chicken” and “chair” start with CH so they may be difficult. Thai speakers will often say “SH” instead of “CH”. Removed Call, Chin, Cold. Added Came, Camera, Cup. Other C words: Can’t Car, Crab, Cry, Carrot,
