**Nouns** คำนาม

- Nouns are things
- Nouns are names
- Nouns don't describe movement or change
- Examples: cat, banana, star, school
- Singular: one cat, one banana, one star
- Plural: two cats, three bananas, one hundred stars

Verbs คำกริยา

- Verbs are words that tell you about change or action
- Examples: run, fly, write, talk
- Past tense: something happened in the past
- Example: I ran yesterday. He talked yesterday
- Future tense: something will happen in the future
- Example: I will run tomorrow. He will talk tomorrow.

Adjectives คำคุณศัพท์

- Adjectives work with nouns
- Example: fat cat, delicious banana, white star

Adverbs กริยาวิเศษณ์

- Adverbs work with verbs
- Adverbs tell you about the action
- Many adverbs end in -ly
- Example: run fast, fly high, write well, talk clearly

Other Parts of Speech

- Article (Determiner)
- Conjunction: joins parts of sentences or words together
- Participle
- Preposition: links a noun to another word
- Pronoun: used in place of nouns
